Amazing events have recently transpired at Fort Westernaire

After nearly ½ of the Westernaire rental string horses were diagnosed with the Strangles disease earlier this year, they slowly regained their health. Fully recovered and leaving quarantine, the horses are now returning to the kids who love to ride them. Summer show season is currently in full effect; Westernaires are en route to great appearances at shows near and far.

During the outbreak, Westernaires was operating on a severelylimited schedule to contain the spread of this disease. Particularly heartbreaking was the timing: Summer is the primary show season for Westernaires.

With the generosity of alumni, friends, and generous strangers who learned of the strangles outbreak afflicting the rental herd, we were able to raise over \$30,000 to assist in lost revenue and veterinary bills.

A HUGE debt of gratitude is owed also to the Westernaires Wranglers who worked tirelessly caring for the recovering horses. Along with great veterinary oversight, the Wranglers' day and night shift work and stringent biosecurity protocols were the key to containing the outbreak and ensuring the swiftest possible recuperation time.

We will continue to keep the GoFundMe campaign page open with hopes that we can persist in raising as much money as possible to help with the massive financial loss that was incurred by Westernaires (https://www.gofundme.com/WesternairesHerdHelp). A great big THANK YOU to everyone who has taken the time to care about these horses, the kids, and the Westernaires organization.
