The 2017 Annual "Horsecapades" Show

Oct. 28th & 29th

There are four Westernaires Horsecapades shows this year. Show times are: Saturday, October 28, 10:00 AM Saturday, October 28, 2:00 PM* Saturday, October 28, 7:00 PM* Sunday, October 29, 2:00 PM* *preshow begins 30 minutes beforehand

Tickets are \$10.00 each. If you don't know any current riders from whom to purchase tickets, you can:

- Mail us a check or money order. Please include the number of tickets you wish to purchase, the show(s) you wish to attend, your mailing address, and how you wish to take delivery of the tickets. We can either send the tickets to you, or you can pick them up at the Will Call window on the day of the show.
- Show up on the day of the show and purchase tickets at the ticket window. However, many shows sell out, so purchasing your tickets in advance is a wise decision!

Horses are available to borrow from specific Westernaires teams (i.e., acts that do not occur in close proximity to the Alumni act). Horses are available on a first-come, first

If you are an alumna or alumnus who would like to bring your own horse to bring your horse to Annual Show, there are a few things to know:

Upon your arrival on Saturday morning before the first show, please stop in at the Barn Office (it's on the northeast side of warm-up arena) and check in with the Barn Superintendent. Stalls are available on a first come, first served basis. The Barn Superintendent will provide you will a stall and a stall card. The stall fees will be approximately \$35.00 for the weekend. Please bring your own feed and any necessary supplements and tack that you may



Adult Ride Program begins its season soon!

The Fall 2017 Adult Ride season is right around the corner! Needing an affordable and easy way to get some saddle time? Care to brush up on your riding skills? Or, maybe your friend or spouse has always wanted to learn to ride? This is the program! While you may bring your own horse, most riders opt to rent a Westernaires rental string horse.

Come to the (mandatory) orientation session to learn all about this fun, low pressure, positive, and encouraging program. Orientation is scheduled for November 1st, from 7PM to 9PM in the Westernaires Red Arena (at Fort Westernaire).

Whether you're a new rider or a seasoned veteran, participants MUST attend this orientation meeting. Again, participants need no prior horse experience to participate – the program instructors are very friendly, and start nice and slow for the beginners. You do NOT need prior Westernaires experience to participate. We look forward to seeing you there!

It happens on occasion: a young rider is unable to come up with the funds necessary to continue in Westernaires. Westernaires has always worked keep their fees at the lowest possible levels for riders, however, in Because WAA is a trying times they can add up.

pate in their classes during tough financial times.


501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, we require information pertaining to how the funds will be used. We also require that a request form be completed.
